Beth yw'r cysylltiad?

Yn cyd-fynd â 'Cymru Iachach', mae gweledigaeth hirdymor Llywodraeth Cymru ar gyfer iechyd a gofal cymdeithasol, 'Fferylliaeth: Cyflawni Cymru Iachach' yn nodi nodau hirdymor gyda chamau gweithredu tymor byr sy'n ofynnol i weddnewid rôl a chyfraniad fferyllwyr, technegwyr fferylliaeth, timau fferyllfa a safleoedd fferyllol. Mae sepsis yn broblem i bawb ac fel gweithwyr fferyllol profesiynol mae angen i ni allu adnabod ac ymateb i arwyddion a symptomau rhybudd y cyflwr hwn.

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Pharmacy: Delivering a Healthier Wales and Sepsis Awareness

What's the link?

Aligned to 'A Healthier Wales', the Welsh Government's long term vision for health and social care, 'Pharmacy: Delivering a Healthier Wales' sets out long term goals with short term actions required to transform the role and contribution of pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, pharmacy teams and pharmacy premises.

This session will highlight the vision outlined in this document and the future implications to practice.

The increased contribution of pharmacy teams to improving the health and wellbeing of the citizens of Wales detailed in the vision highlights the increased need for pharmacy teams to have an understanding of the recognition and management of a variety of health conditions. This session will look at one condition in more detail, sepsis. Sepsis is a serious and potentially life-threatening condition, however if it is diagnosed appropriately, it can result in excellent patient outcomes. Sepsis is everyone's problem and as pharmacy professionals we need to be able to identify and respond to the warning signs and symptoms of this condition.

This session will cover the recognition and practical management of sepsis through the completion of case studies, representing all areas of pharmacy practice. This is an exciting opportunity to learn from each other in order to deliver a better service for our patients.

- Develop an awareness and understanding of 'Pharmacy: Delivering a Healthier Wales'
- Describe the implications of 'Pharmacy: Delivering a Healthier Wales'
- Define sepsis and the different stages of this condition
- Outline the epidemiology and aetiology of sepsis
- Identify early warning systems and triage/screening tools for sepsis
- Recognise the "red flags" symptoms for sepsis and referral guidance
- Utilise knowledge to provide advice and safe signposting to patients
- Demonstrate application of knowledge, through completion of case-based scenarios
