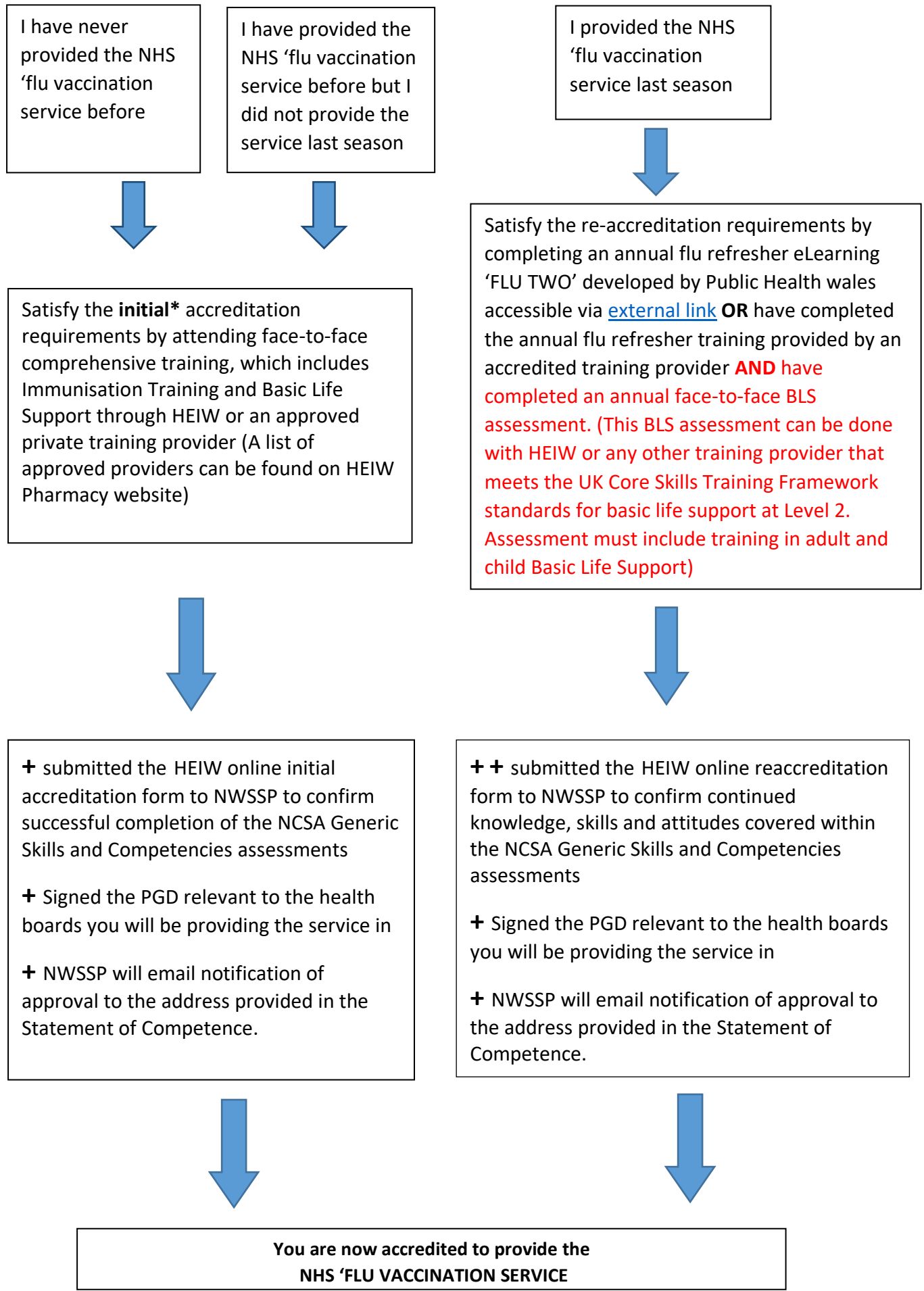


ACCREDITATION FLOWCHART FOR THE PROVISION OF NHS INFLUENZA VACCINATION SERVICE 2023-24

Satisfy the **initial*** accreditation requirements by attending face-to-face comprehensive training, which includes Immunisation Training and Basic Life Support through HEIW or an approved private training provider (A list of approved providers can be found on HEIW Pharmacy website)

Satisfy the re-accreditation requirements by completing an annual flu refresher eLearning 'FLU TWO' developed by Public Health Wales accessible via [external link](#) OR have completed the annual flu refresher training provided by an accredited training provider **AND have completed an annual face-to-face BLS assessment. (This BLS assessment can be done with HEIW or any other training provider that meets the UK Core Skills Training Framework standards for basic life support at Level 2. Assessment must include training in adult and child Basic Life Support)**

- + submitted the HEIW online initial accreditation form to NWSSP to confirm successful completion of the NCSA Generic Skills and Competencies assessments
- + Signed the PGD relevant to the health boards you will be providing the service in
- + NWSSP will email notification of approval to the address provided in the Statement of Competence.

- ++ submitted the HEIW online re-accreditation form to NWSSP to confirm continued knowledge, skills and attitudes covered within the NCSA Generic Skills and Competencies assessments
- + Signed the PGD relevant to the health boards you will be providing the service in
- + NWSSP will email notification of approval to the address provided in the Statement of Competence.
